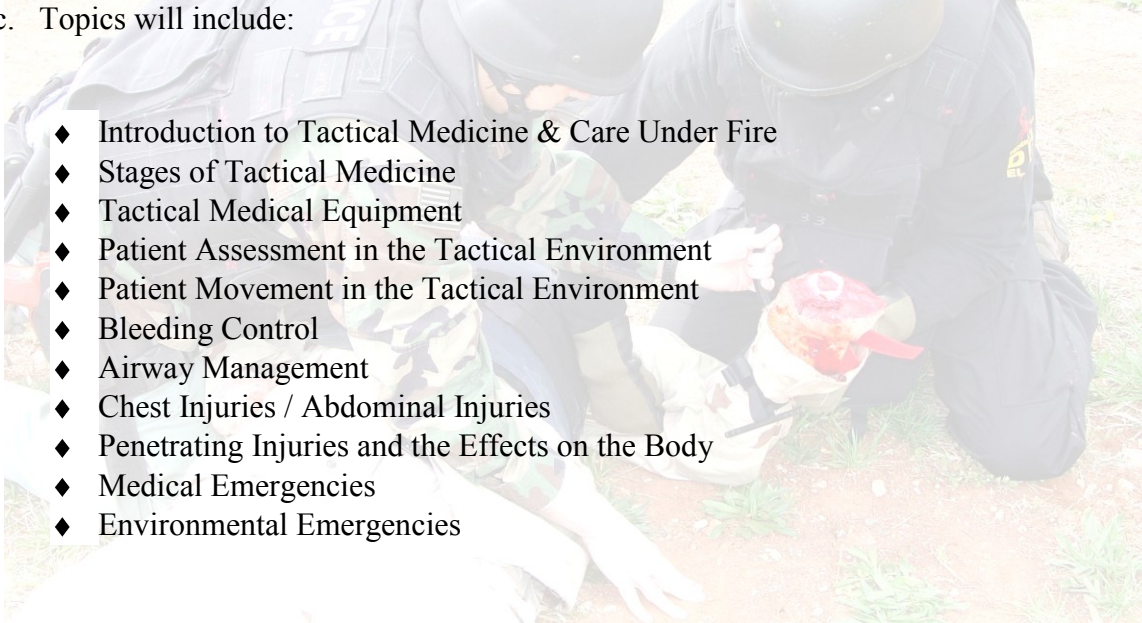

Law Enforcement First Aid and Safety Training Basic Course (LEFAST)

The Law Enforcement First Aid and Safety Training (LEFAST) Basic course is an 8 hour course designed to train Law Enforcement officers on the emphasis of dealing with life threatening emergencies faced in the line of duty. Students will learn self aid and buddy aid in a wide variety of tactical and medical situations. LEFAST Basic is a hands on, physically challenging and scenario based course. Students will receive lectures in the morning and will be placed in real life tactical situations which require medical care to themselves and their teammates in the afternoon. Students will learn the importance of providing medical treatment during the different stages of care under fire, tactical field care and evacuation care. Some scenarios will incorporate simulation guns to make the training more realistic. Topics will include:



- ◆ Introduction to Tactical Medicine & Care Under Fire
- ◆ Stages of Tactical Medicine
- ◆ Tactical Medical Equipment
- ◆ Patient Assessment in the Tactical Environment
- ◆ Patient Movement in the Tactical Environment
- ◆ Bleeding Control
- ◆ Airway Management
- ◆ Chest Injuries / Abdominal Injuries
- ◆ Penetrating Injuries and the Effects on the Body
- ◆ Medical Emergencies
- ◆ Environmental Emergencies

This course is being offered by Medical Outfitter Training Consultants, LLC.
